RRDS Govt. Degree College, Bhimavaram was established in 1972 by Sri Murthy Raju garu who founded 68 educational institutions under the umbrella of Sri Chintalapati Bapiraju Dharma Samsthalu. Sri Murthy Raju, a known freedom fighter, lived as a true Gandhian, led the Sarvodaya Movement in the region, and acted as a Minister for Endowment in the state. He envisioned the vital role of education in uplifting the society from all its ills and championed the cause of education for all by donating around 2000 acres of his ancestral property for creating educational opportunities even in the remote areas. RRDS College was named after Sri Raja Rammohan Roy as “Raja Ramamohunroy Dwi Sathajayanthi College” commemorating the Bicentenary Birth Celebrations of the social reformer. The College was accredited by NAAC, Bangalore in 2015. It is affiliated to Adikavi Nannaya University, Rajahmundry. It offers UG courses: BA (H-E-PA), BCOM (Gen) and BCOM (Computers).
